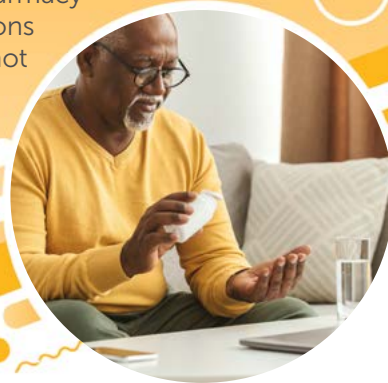

Through its offices in Winston-Salem and Kernersville, Crisis Control Ministry provides short-term emergency services, including assistance with mortgage and rent payments, utility bills, food, and prescription medication to Forsyth and Stokes County residents.

#### PHARMACY ASSISTANCE

Our free licensed pharmacy distributes prescriptions to patients who cannot afford medications for acute and chronic conditions.



Cline, a local big box store employee, has been on medical leave since January due to an on-the-job injury. Despite filing for Workers' Compensation, he has not received any payments, leading to the lapse of his medical insurance. Unable to afford his insulin and heart medication, Cline reached out to Crisis Control Ministry's Free Pharmacy for help. Because of your kind-hearted generosity, Crisis Control was able to cover both of Cline's essential medications for the next year or until he returns to work and his insurance is reinstated. Your support not only ensures that Cline has consistent access to his prescribed medications but also plays a crucial role in his recovery process, allowing him to focus on healing without the added stress of financial burden.

Our pharmacy filled **20,609** prescriptions free of charge for neighbors in need in 2023.
