Crisis Control Ministry has seen a **369% increase** in food assistance since the COVID-19 pandemic hit our region.

The demand for our pantry assistance has nearly **doubled over the past year.**

Tosha is a dedicated worker who commutes from Winston-Salem to her job near the airport in Greensboro. She faced a financial crisis when her car broke down. While her car was in the shop for repair, she was unable to work all her shifts, significantly reducing her income. After weeks of partial paychecks, Tosha struggled to pay her bills and feed her family. In her time of need, she reached out to Crisis Control Ministry.
